12 YEARS AND ABOVE

OREGON HAS THE HIGHEST MARIJUANA USE IN THE NATION

108% higher than the national average

152% higher than Idaho

12-17 YEAR-OLDS

VERMONT HAS THE HIGHEST MARIJUANA USE IN THE NATION (MEDI-POT ONLY)

64% higher than the national average

70% higher than Idaho

18-25 YEAR-OLDS

VERMONT HAS THE HIGHEST MARIJUANA USE IN THE NATION (MEDI-POT ONLY)

80% higher than the national average

141% higher than Idaho

26 YEARS AND ABOVE

OREGON HAS THE HIGHEST MARIJUANA USE IN THE NATION

138% higher than the national average

183% higher than Idaho
